**SEM Committee Decision for the Regulatory Authorities in relation to Mod\_22\_11  
(Recommendation Report FRR\_22\_11\_V1.0)**

Dear Sherine,

On 5<sup>th</sup> July 2011, the Modifications Committee submitted its Modification Recommendation Report with regard to a Modification Proposal, Mod\_22\_11 (House Keeping 4) in accordance with paragraph 2.213 of the SEM Trading and Settlement Code (the Code).

This Modification Proposal, proposed by SEMO, seeks to corrects minor drafting errors of various sections of the Code.

The SEM Committee notes that the Modifications Committee agreed unanimously that the Modification Proposal furthers the Code Objectives "To facilitate the efficient discharge by the Market Operator of the obligations imposed upon it by its Market Operator Licences". The SEM Committee further notes that the Modification requires no changes to the Central Market Systems.

Considering the above, and in accordance with paragraph 2.218 of the Code, the SEM Committee directs that a Modification be made in accordance with the Final Recommendation Report of the Modifications Committee (FRR\_22\_11\_V1.0).

The Regulatory Authorities therefore direct that a Modification be made on a Settlement Day basis with effect from the next Working Day after the date of this letter.
