SEM Committee Decision for the Regulatory Authorities in relation to Mod\_04\_11 (Recommendation Report FRR\_04\_11\_V2.0)

Dear Sherine,

On 18<sup>th</sup> January 2012, the Modifications Committee submitted its Modification Recommendation Report with regard to a Modification Proposal, Mod\_04\_11 (Facilitating Demand Side Units with an MEC less than 10MW to participate as part of a Demand Site Unit), in accordance with paragraph 2.213 of the SEM Trading and Settlement Code (the Code).

This Modification Proposal, which was raised by the Fingleton White & Co, seeks to allow a demand site with a Maximum Export Capacity (MEC) of less than 10MW to participate in the SEM as a Demand Side Unit.

The SEM Committee notes that the Modifications Committee agreed unanimously that the Modification Proposal furthers the Code Objectives that it "facilitates the efficient, economic and coordinated operation, administration and development of the SEM", "promotes competition in the SEM" and "promotes the long-term interests of consumers of electricity". The Modifications Committee also recommended that the Modification should be made effective on a Trading Day basis, one Working Day after the Regulatory Authority decision is made.

The SEM Committee notes that the required Grid Code changes which are required to give effect to the TSC Modification Proposal have now been approved. Therefore it is appropriate to align the Trading and Settlement Code with the Grid Code changes.
