Updated SEM Committee Decision for the Regulatory Authorities in relation to Mod_10_11

Dear Sherine,

On 21st July 2011, the SEM Committee approved the Modification 10_11 Interconnector Under Test which allows for the application of Testing Tariffs to Interconnectors and was particularly relevant for the East West Interconnector (EWIC) during commissioning.

Since that approval, the Market Operator (SEMO), proposed the Modification Proposal 33_11 (Temporary exclusion of Interconnector Error Unit Testing Charges from Settlement calculations) which provides an internal business process to apply testing tariffs to EWIC at commissioning and before the required Central Market System (CMS) changes are made.

The SEM Committee has approved Mod_33_11 with an effective date of the first day of EWIC commissioning where power flows on the Interconnector. In order to make the manual business process in Mod_33_11 possible, the SEM Committee hereby directs that the effective date of Mod_10_11 should be aligned with that effective date of Mod_33_11 and that the Market Operator shall publish the effective date (in respect of Mod_10_11 and Mod_33_11) on its website no less than one week in advance of that date.
