**SEM Committee Decision for the Regulatory Authorities in relation to Mod\_35\_18 (Final Recommendation Report FRR\_35\_18)**

Dear Esther

On 8 February 2019, the Modifications Committee submitted its Final Recommendation Report with regard to Modification Proposal Mod\_35\_18 “Clarifications to Dispute Process” in accordance with Paragraph B.17.18.1 of Part B of the SEM Trading and Settlement Code (TSC).

Mod\_35\_18 was submitted to the Modifications Committee by SEMO on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2018.

The Modification Proposal seeks to provide clarity and remove inconsistencies in the dispute resolution process. The proposal seeks to address concerns raised during the resolution of Pricing Disputes following I-SEM go live.

A presentation was made at the Modifications Committee meeting on 12 December 2018 and the members of the Modifications Committee voted unanimously for the approval of Mod\_35\_18, subject to two changes being captured in the Final Recommendation Report. The Modifications Committee took the view that the Modification Proposal would better facilitate the achievement of the following Code objectives:

- to facilitate the efficient discharge by the Market Operator of the obligations imposed upon it by its Market Operator Licenses;
- to facilitate the efficient, economic and coordinated operation, administration and development of the Single Electricity Market in a financially secure manner;
- to provide transparency in the operation of the Single Electricity Market.

Considering the above, and in accordance with Paragraph B.17.20 of Part B of the TSC, the SEM Committee direct a Modification in accordance with the 'Proposed Legal Drafting' section of the FRR\_35\_18. This Modification shall become effective two Working Days after the date of this letter.
