Explanation of Proposed Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>			
<p>The RAs have undertaken a review of the Capacity Market Code ahead of the next T-4 auction. In doing so, a number of Modification Proposals are being raised. This proposal aims to clarify how the Code Provisions D.2.1.10 and D.2.1.12 operate.</p> <p>Pertaining to this modification, D.2.1.10 stipulates no time frame for the amendment of the capacity auction timetable. However, D.2.1.12 does provide a timeframe for the delay or postponement of a capacity auction under D.2.1.12(a) and for the cancellation of a capacity auction under D.2.1.12(b).</p> <p>The RAs are proposing to amend the Capacity Market Code to clarify that the powers of the SOs and RAs provided under D.2.1.10 are not limited, thus allowing amendments to the Capacity Auction Timetable at short notice.</p>

<p>D.2.1.12 No later than five Working Days prior to the Capacity Auction Submission Commencement date specified in relation to a Capacity Auction in the applicable Capacity Auction Timetable, the Regulatory Authorities may instruct the System Operators to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) delay or postpone the Capacity Auction; or (b) cancel the Capacity Auction. <p><u>This paragraph D.2.1.12 is without prejudice to the powers of the System Operators and the Regulatory Authorities under paragraph D.2.1.10.</u></p>			
Modification Proposal Justification <i>(Clearly state the reason for the Modification)</i>			

Changes as outlined above are justified to address a potential lack of clarity as to the interpretation of two provisions of the Capacity Market Code and to clarify the scope of the powers of the SOs and RAs as set out in the Code.

The proposal at hand seeks to clarify that the Regulatory Authorities can use their powers when required to amend the Capacity Auction Timetable ahead of future auctions.

Code Objectives Furthered

This Modification Proposal would further the following CMC Objectives:

(g) through the development of the Capacity Market, to promote the short-term and long-term interests of consumers of electricity with respect to price, quality, reliability, and security of supply of electricity across the Island of Ireland

1. If a person submits a Modification Proposal on behalf of another person, that person who proposes the material of the change should be identified on the Modification Proposal Form as the Modification Proposal Originator.
2. Any person raising a Modification Proposal shall ensure that their proposal is clear and substantiated with the appropriate detail including the way in which it furthers the Code Objectives to enable it to be fully considered by the Regulatory Authorities.
3. Each Modification Proposal will include a draft text of the proposed Modification to the Code unless, if raising a Provisional Modification Proposal whereby legal drafting text is not imperative.
4. For the purposes of this Modification Proposal Form, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

CMC / Code:	means the Capacity Market Code for the Single Electricity Market
Modification Proposal:	means the proposal to modify the Code as set out in the attached form
Derivative Work:	means any text or work which incorporates or contains all or part of the Modification Proposal or any adaptation, abridgement, expansion or other modification of the Modification Proposal

The terms "System Operators" and "Regulatory Authorities" shall have the meanings assigned to those terms in the Code.

In consideration for the right to submit, and have the Modification Proposal assessed in accordance with the terms of Section B.12 of the Code, which I have read and understand, I agree as follows:

1. I hereby grant a worldwide, perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive licence:
 - 1.1 to the System Operators and the Regulatory Authorities to publish and/or distribute the Modification Proposal for free and unrestricted access;
