## 1.1 SECRETARIAT UPDATE

Secretariat welcomed all to Capacity Market Modifications Workshop 48 with the Chairperson providing an overview of the agenda and the proposals that would be discussed. Programme of Work update was given confirming that V14.0 of the Code was published.

### RA Update

The RAs gave a [presentation](#) on the outstanding Modification Proposals noting that decisions will be issued in the coming months. It was advised that a decision had been published on CMC\_07\_24 with an effective date of 5<sup>th</sup> March 2026.

An update was requested on CMC\_11\_21 and assurance was given by the RAs that engagement with TSOs was ongoing with a view to providing this feedback shortly.

### TSO Update

TSO delivered a [presentation](#) on the Capacity Market Platform Development Plan with the following updates:

CMC\_07\_24 – It was noted that this important change was introduced to enable the auction algorithm facilitate contracts of shorter duration. TSO advised that the effective date was confirmed in the T-4 29/30 Final Auction Information Pack and it will be in place for upcoming auction.

CMC\_09\_22 – It was advised that a new robust process for secondary trading was currently in process and will go-live in April 2026. A listing of training sessions was given, and Participants were encouraged to attend the feedback sessions.

CMC\_11\_21 – It was noted that requirements for this process were being discussed and TSOs were engaging with RAs as part of the Impact Assessment.

Post Auction improvements – noted that this would be worked on following impact assessment of secondary trading.

## CMC\_01\_26

Proposer delivered a [presentation](#) noting that this was raised to improve governance of the Capacity Market Code on this matter. A summary of the Capacity Auction Monitor reports currently issued to the RAs was given along with their timelines. It was advised that these timelines would be extended from 2 days to 7 days to align with what is practicable in reality and that a ‘two stage’ approach was proposed to provide a window in the Code for SO engagement.

Legal drafting was discussed and assurance was given that there would be no adverse impacts to the timelines being extended.

### **Modification Status – Under Consultation**

## CMC\_02\_26

Proposer delivered a [presentation](#) noting that 2 existing provisions were redundant and were causing adverse consequences. An overview of these provisions was given noting that there was currently a mechanism in place under the auction with no need for manual adjustment, meaning that the provisions are redundant.

It was advised that with this proposal the RAs would continue to receive the true capacity position and sight of capacity shortfalls. As the proposal is merely looking to align the Code with the prudent SO status quo there would be no adverse impact from this.

A Participant queried the level of information provided to RAs and if there was a possibility that more information could be provided. TSO confirmed that they are fully audited in everything they do and asked for feedback to be provided in the consultation process.

### **Modification Status – Under Consultation**

#### CMC\_03\_26

Proposer delivered a [presentation](#) noting 2 unrelated changes which were included in this proposal. One to introduce discretion through F.3.1.6 and the other to correct a typo that was flagged in CMC\_01\_22.

### **Modification Status – Under Consultation**

Secretariat advised that Workshop 49 would be scheduled for Wednesday, 27<sup>th</sup> May 2026 with a closing date for proposals on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2026.

Secretariat also highlighted upcoming data review of the Capacity Modifications subscription lists. Current subscribers will receive an email with steps to follow to continue to receive Capacity Modifications communications.
