SEM Committee Decision for the Regulatory Authorities in relation to Mod_01_26 ‘Implementation of ASP Decision SEM-25-029’ (Final Recommendation FRR_01_26)

Dear Esther,

On the 13th of July 2026, the Modifications Committee submitted its Final Recommendation Report (FRR) regarding Modification Proposal Mod_01_26 ‘Implementation of ASP Decision SEM-25-029’ in accordance with Paragraph B.17.18.1 of the SEM Trading and Settlement Code (TSC). Modification Proposal Mod_01_26 was submitted to the Modifications Committee by CRU and UREGNI on the 30th of March 2026. The Modification Proposal was discussed at Modifications Committee Meeting 134 and voted on at Modifications Committee Meeting 135 on Thursday 18th June 2026.

This Modification Proposal amends the definition of Short-Term Reserve Quantity in the TSC Glossary to refer to available Replacement Reserves only, i.e., by removing reference to Tertiary Operating Reserve Band 2, in line with the SEM Committee’s decision outlined in SEM-25-029¹. This Modification Proposal also amends the terms “Short-Term Reserve Quantity” and “Operating Reserve Requirement Quantity” to “Available Reserve Quantity” and “Required Reserve Quantity” respectively throughout the TSC Glossary and Sections E.4.2 and E.4.3.

The RAs note that Modification Proposal Mod_01_26 was recommended for approval by the Modifications Committee.

Considering the above, and in accordance with Paragraph B.17.20 of the Trading and Settlement Code, the SEM Committee approves this Modification Proposal, as set out in Appendix 1 of FRR_01_26, to be
